


RAYJON CURLING EVENT 2024 – REGISTRATION PACKAGE

Welcome! Thank you for your interest in participating in the 5th annual Curling Event for Rayjon to be held on Saturday, November 23 at the Sarnia Golf & Curling Club.

- As in previous years, the goals of Rayjon's Curling event are:
 - Have fun
 - o Be safe
 - Educate participants on Rayjon's work in Haiti and the DR
 - Raise funds to support the Pinson Community School in the rural St. Marc region of Haiti. Our goal this year is \$8,000.



Event Details

Registration begins at 1:30 pm

Briefing 2:00 pm

On-ice orientation 2:30 pm + start when ready.

Finish at 5:00 pm. No break is planned this year.

Dinner served at 5:15 pm. We need to know if you have any dietary restrictions *prior to November 23* – so kitchen can make special arrangements.

Presentations and door prizes at 6:00 pm. Wrap up by 6:45 pm.

Cost and Fundraising

• Cost of registration is \$60 (adults) and \$30 (youth), payable at time of registration. Registration fees plus donations from sponsors covers all associated costs for the day.

- A cash bar will be available.
- Everyone is asked to collect pledges / donations in support of the Pinson Community School in Haiti. See details at the end of this document.

Ground rules

- Everyone welcome whether you are a regular curler or a beginner.
- Non-curlers (e.g. friends & family members of curlers) very welcome to join us. If they would like to join us for dinner, they will need to register along with the curlers.
- Curlers will be required to follow SG&CC safety procedures and sign waiver form on arrival at event prior to going on to ice.
- 8 sheets with 2 teams per sheet. Each team = min. 3 curlers. Max. = 4. Each sheet = min. 6 curlers. Max. = 8. Can include 2 non-curlers at team table. Overall, can accommodate 64 curlers + non-curlers. Min. = 48 curlers + max. = 16 non-curlers.
- Also, we plan to accommodate a limited number of "Friends of Rayjon" (not team members). They will need to register ahead of time if they would like dinner + access to door prizes.

What to wear (curlers):

- Most important items are headwear and footwear:
 - o *Helmets* are *mandatory* for young curlers and strongly advised for all adults.
 - Bring clean pair of running shoes (or equivalent) with you to change into when you arrive. You will be provided with "grippers" to wear on top of your running shoes.
- Equipment:
 - For less experienced curlers, SG&CC will provide "poles" / "sticks" to use to deliver rocks rather than rely on "sliders". This will be explained at the on-ice orientation. You will be given an opportunity to try them out.



How to Fundraise (collect pledges)

There are two methods of collecting pledges:

- 1. Printed pledge form, <u>available to download here</u>. Simply print and complete the form, collect cash and/or cheques from your donors, and hand in the form and all collected pledges at registration on November 23th. Please note:
 - o Donations of \$20 or more will receive a charitable receipt for tax purposes.
 - Please be sure to print legibly and clearly, and to collect complete address and contact information from all donors (including email addresses when possible).
 - o Cheques should be made payable to **Rayjon Share Care of Sarnia Inc.**

2. Collect online pledges

- You can share the link in a personal email, on Facebook/social media, or in any other way you choose.
- Donors simply click on the button to complete the pledge online. Tax receipts are issued automatically.
